NEIL ADKINS LINEWORKER SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES



The Neil T. Adkins Scholarship was set up in memory of our son who was killed in an automobile accident in June 2009. Neil was 20 years old and had attended Bismarck State College in the Lineworker Program. In May, he had begun his new career with 3-C Construction in Bismarck and was enjoying his success in the Lineworker field. Neil was a lifelong resident of Wyoming and received the WREA Scholarship to help him achieve his goal. In memory of Neil, we hope this scholarship will help a deserving student become successful in the Lineworker Program.

OBJECTIVE:

To encourage, promote, and educate lineworkers for enduring and rewarding careers with Wyoming's electric cooperatives.

POLICY:

I. Availability

- A. Scholarships are available to applicants who plan to attend an approved regional lineworker training program.
- B. One scholarship will be awarded each year.
- C. The scholarship shall be in the amount of \$500.00.
- D. The scholarship is available to all Wyoming residents or any person who is a member or a child of such member, who lives in the home, that receives electrical services from a Wyoming electric cooperative association.

II. Selection Process

- A. Candidates must submit a scholarship application to their local cooperative or WREA.
- B. Completed scholarship application must be mailed, faxed or emailed no later than March 1st.

- C. Completed scholarship applications will be reviewed by the WREA Scholarship Committee and the WREA Board of Directors. In order for the application to be considered it must include the following:
 - 1. Scholarship applications must include:

- 1. An application form.
- 2. A resume detailing employment experience, duties, and any specialized skills.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation.
- 4. A transcript of grades from any educational institution attended within the past three (3) years and/or proof of GED certificate.

III. Payment

- A. The first scholarship payment will be made when the student enrolls in the next available session or semester of an approved regional lineworker training program.
- B. The scholarship will be paid in installment and will be paid directly to the student's account at his/her school of choice.

IV. Post-School Obligation

A. The scholarship recipient is obligated, upon completion of the lineworker program to notify WREA of his/her availability for employment by sending a resume and cover letter to WREA. Filing a resume will not guarantee employment with a Wyoming co-op. Failure to provide a resume and cover letter to WREA will result in repayment of the scholarship monies received from WREA.
